The Taylor Center of Natural History and Koteewi Trace

Visitors are encouraged to visit the Taylor Center of Natural History to learn about the exciting archaeological discoveries that have been uncovered at Strawtown Koteewi Park. Artifacts and educational displays remind park guests that the land that is now Strawtown Koteewi Park holds a rich and fascinating history.



Take a short walk outside the Taylor Center and visit Koteewi Trace, a replicated Native American village site. Guests are encouraged to enter the life-sized structures where they are transported back in history to a time when it is believed that similar architecture once dotted the park landscape. While visiting Koteewi Trace, explore the one-of-a-kind "mock dig" site to learn more about the fascinating science and methodology of archaeology.



The Taylor Center of Natural History is open daily and throughout the year offers special tours, events and activities; most are free to the public. 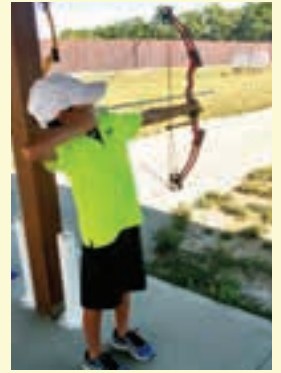
